

Gotherington Village Hall – Hirer's FAQs

Last updated May 2021.

PLEASE READ ALONGSIDE HALL AND COVID T&Cs.

1. How many tables and chairs do you have?

We have ten large tables which seat 6 and 12 smaller tables which seat 4.

2. Do you have chairs?

Yes, we have 96 folding chairs.

We also have four toddler tables with small chairs.

3. Do I need to bring my own tea towels, washing up liquid etc.?

We will provide washing up liquid. Due to COVID, we are unable to provide teatowels at this time, and you will need to bring your own.

4. Are there any cooking facilities?

Yes, we have an electric oven, gas hob plus microwave. We also have a fridge but all food MUST be removed at the end of each hire.

5. What are the maximum occupancy numbers I can have?

Normally, the maximum occupancy figures are 80 seated at tables or 120 standing.

Due to COVID restrictions the current maximum occupancy is 25 individuals, and no more than 2 people in the kitchen at any time.

5. Can I book a bouncy castle?

Yes, but the maximum headroom is 2 metres. When making your booking on Hallmaster you must tell us you intend to hire a bouncy castle and we will need to see a copy of the companies Public Liability Insurance document before allowing access. It is the responsibility of the hirer/bouncy castle provider to insure the activity.

6. Are dogs allowed?

There are no dogs allowed except sight or hearing dogs.

7. Can I use the toys in the store cupboard?

No, not under any circumstances. They do not belong to the village hall so are not included in the hire agreement.

8. Is there any wi-fi?

No unfortunately not, though we are looking at options.

9. Is there any music system available?

Yes, we have a bluetooth music system available to use.
